
Subject: Performance of domestic airlines for the year 2025.

Traffic data submitted by various domestic airlines has been analysed for the month of September 2025.


Passenger Growth

Passengers carried by domestic airlines during January-September 2025 were **1233.70 lakhs** as against **1184.93 lakhs** during the corresponding period of the previous year thereby registering an annual growth of **4.12** % and monthly growth of **-2.95** %.



Passenger Load Factor



Passenger Complaints during the month






Various reasons of passenger complaints are indicated below:















Reasons for delay have been analysed, which are presented below. It has been found that the majority of delays have been attributed to 'Reactionary'.




Revenue Earned & Seats Sold in Highest Fare Bucket


