Incorporated in 1998, IGL is a Joint Venture of GAIL and BPCL. Govt. of NCT of Delhi is also holding 5% equity

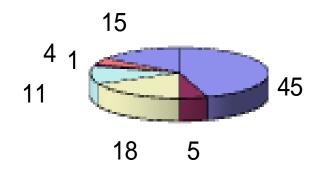
IGL started its operations in NCT of Delhi in 1999 with only 9 CNG stations and 1000 PNG consumers

Fuelling the largest CNG Bus fleet in the World



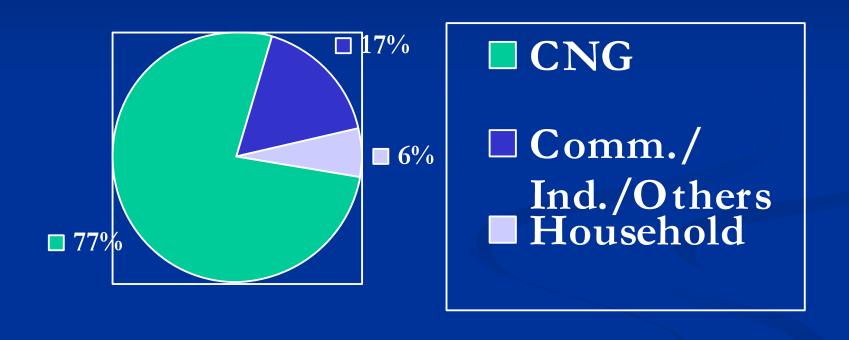

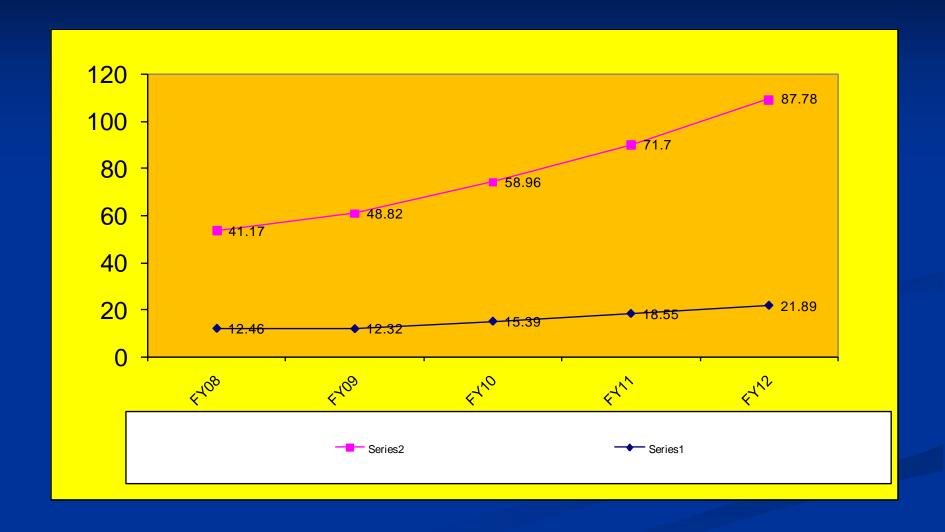

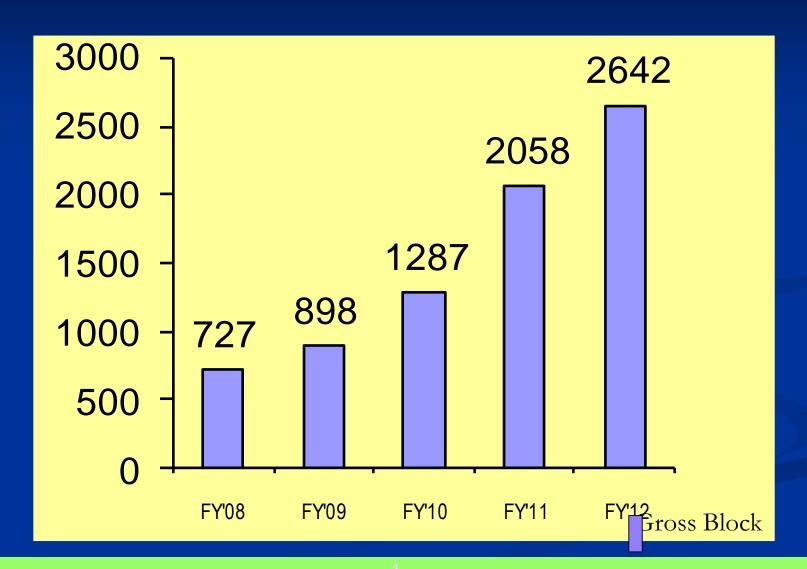
## Book Value & EPS

# Growth-Strategy

- Improve penetration of PNG business:
  - > Penetration of network in all charge areas
  - > Target Industrial/Commercial customers in both Delhi & NCR

# Risks & Mitigations



- Gas price increase
  - > Increases have been passed on to customers
  - CNG price still remains competitive vis-à-vis petrol

- Availability of gas
  - > Firm allocation from Govt. of India
  - > Buying gas from GAIL/BPCL
  - > Recently tied up more RLNG from GAIL/BPCL
