





The lab would develop 5 biological crop protection patented products over a period of 5 Years











#### Performance Highlights: Q1 FY 2025-26 Vs Q1 FY 2024-25




#### **Urea Production and Sales (In Lakhs MT)**

#### P & K Fertilisers Sales (In Lakhs MT)




#### Financial Position – Standalone (Rs. In Crore)






