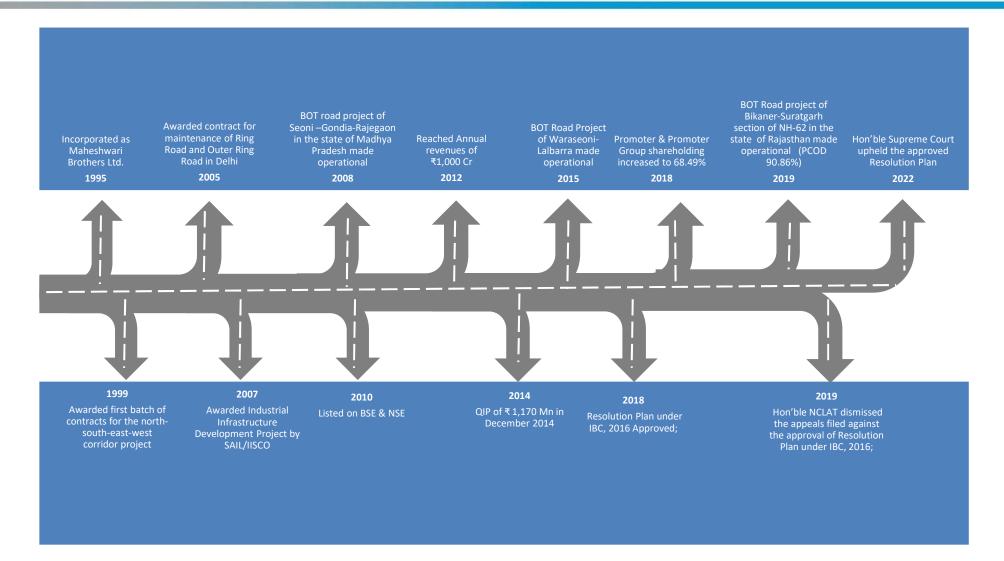

## Resolution Plan under IBC, 2016



Plan

Resolution plan dated 22.11.2017 submitted by Mr. A K Lakhotia was approved by Hon'ble NCLT by order dated 18.04.2018. Appeals against the same were dismissed by Hon'ble NCLAT by order dated 16.08.2019 finding them without any merit. Civil appeal no. 8411 of 2019 against order of NCLAT had been disposed of by Hon'ble Supreme Court by order dated 18.01.2022. The Resolution Plan has accordingly attained finality. Hon'ble NCLT by order dated 11.03.22,inter-alia, excluded the period from 18.04.2018 till the order & judgement of Hon'ble Supreme Court from the calculation of period of implementation of Plan. Hon'ble NCLAT vide order & judgement dated 23.05.2023 has disposed of the appeal filed by one of the banks against NCLT order dated 11.03.2022 and has directed all stakeholders to carry out their obligations for implementation of the resolution plan. Hon'ble Supreme Court has vide order dated 04.08.2023 dismissed the civil appeal no. 4636 of 2023 filed against NCLAT order dated 23.05.2023.

Terms of Plan

- Payment of CIRP cost and workmen dues already paid.
- •Operational creditors to be paid in three years from implementation of the plan
- Statutory dues to be paid in 3 years commencing from 3 years from implementation of plan.
- •Banks:
- -Cash credit facility @ one year MCLR of SBI plus spread of 0.70% p.a aggregating to ₹ 37.38 crores
- -Working Capital Term Loan @ one year MCLR of SBI plus spread of 0.70% p.a. aggregating to ₹ 37.38 crores
  - -Issuance of 0.10% Secured Non-convertible debentures (NCDs) aggregating to ₹ 880.85 crores redeemable in 39 unequated instalments (at a premium of 10% at the time of final redemption).
  - -External Commercial Borrowings be restructured to be paid in 39 unequated instalments @ one year MCLR of SBI plus spread of 0.70% p.a. in Indian rupees.
  - -Term Loans from NBFC Lenders to be restructured to be paid in 39 unequated instalments @ one year MCLR of SBI plus spread of 0.70% p.a.
- Payment of liquidation value to the dissenting financial creditors on priority (provision made).

**Issue of NCDs** 

NCDs aggregating to ₹ 880.85 crores issued to assenting Banks repayable in 39 unequated quarterly installments with coupon rate of 0.10% p.a. and to be redeemed at premium of 10% of the face value at the end of the tenure. NCDs to be reissued after reconciliation in demat form on execution of working capital documents by Banks.

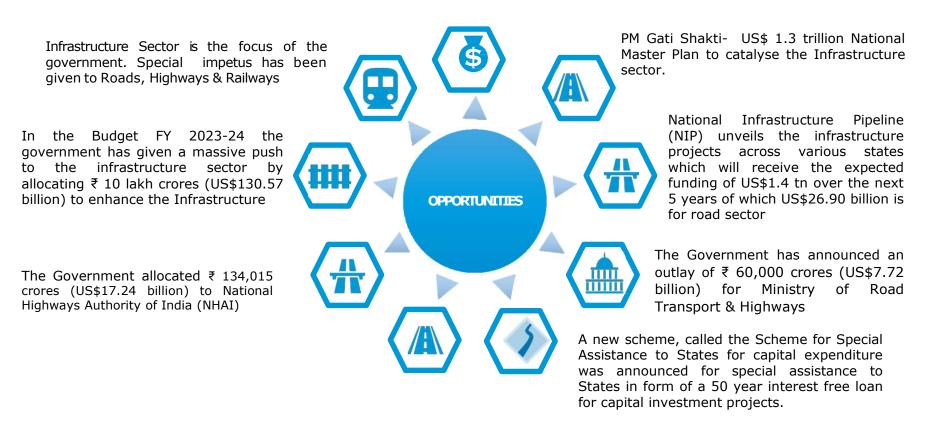
**Equity Infusion** 

- •In terms of the Resolution Plan contribution from the Promoters and Promoters Group will be ₹ 128.19 Cr over a period of three years. The Promoters have already infused ₹ 63.30 Cr. (₹ 40.10 crores fresh induction and ₹ 23.19 crores out of existing dues)
- Equity holding of the Promoter and Promoter group has increased to 68.27%.
