#### **Financial Performance**

The company registered an YoY increase in Profit After Tax by 731% for H1 FY26, and by 507% for Q2 FY26.

  - Mumbai Refinery registered throughput of 5.09 MMT operating at 107% of its name plate capacity of 9.50 MMTPA
- Refineries recorded crude throughput of 6.57 MMT in Q2 FY26, up 4.3% from 6.30 MMT in Q2 FY25.
  - Visakh Refinery registered crude throughput of 3.98 MMT operating at 105% of its name plate capacity
  - Mumbai Refinery registered throughput of 2.59 MMT operating at 108% of its name plate capacity
- One new grade of crude oil was processed during Q2 FY26, taking the total number of new grades processed during H1 FY26 to five.
